Memorandum of Agreement

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This memorandum of Agreement is made and entered into by and between:

Big Hands Australia Limited,

A non-stock, non-profit organization existing under the Australian law, with office address Suite 10, 1 East Ridge Drive, Chirnside Park, Victoria, 3116 Australia, represented herein by J Carlos Bello, Big Hands Director, hereinafter referred to as the FIRST PARTY;

and

Municipality of Taytay – Taytay Rizal

A duly organized local government unit, with office address at Municipal Health Office, Don Hilario Ave., Club Manila East Compound, Barangay San Juan, Taytay, Rizal represented herein by Hon. Mayor Allan Martine S. De Leon, hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY;

Witnesseth that:

WHEREAS, BOTH PARTIES believe in community empowerment and advancing healthcare and education, in doing so we create immediate health solutions and invest in a brighter future for the community;

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY is a private international non-profit organization that upholds the vision of advancing rehabilitative healthcare and health literacy in poor communities in developing countries;

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY initiates and institutionalizes community-based rehabilitation programs and service projects across all divisions in addressing the needs of the community, particularly in health delivery research and education, total well-being;

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY undertakes research, program evaluation, and develops innovative sustainable methods of healthcare system interventions to enhance the capacity of individuals and organizations;

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY wishes to avail of the services of the FIRST PARTY under conditions hereinafter stipulated;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the above premises and of the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties do hereby mutually agree, within the limits of the laws governing their respective existence, to execute this Memorandum of Agreement:

**ARTICLE 1
Responsibilities of the Parties**

The FIRST and SECOND PARTIES agree to be official partners and agree to:

The FIRST PARTY shall provide the following services:

1. Technical expertise in rehabilitative healthcare, health training, and best practice;
2. Assist in guiding research and development of the Taytay's Health staff;
3. Assist in the delivery of the clinical aspect of health training, conferences, medical missions, and other initiatives aimed at empowering the health system of Taytay
4. Support the ongoing technical knowledge of health staff
5. Develop learning materials generated through community based research and development
6. Monitor the operation of programs through regular feedback and consultations

The SECOND PARTY shall commit to undertake the following activities:

1. Provide venue and logistical support for mutually agreed upon initiatives of the FIRST PARTY;
2. Give the legal mandate with the local government to implement the program.

3. Provide necessary mutually agreed upon financial support for initiatives of the FIRST PARTY;
4. Provide information, records and referrals to the FIRST PARTY and facilitate access to Taytay Health;
5. Shall organize the local health staff and promote their active involvement in the program;
6. Coordinate with other partners in an inter-agency undertaking for the smooth implementation of the FIRST party initiatives;
7. Provide linkage and coordination opportunity with existing and future partners of the FIRST PARTY to support the join programs of BOTH PARTIES;
8. Promote the FIRST PARTY to its other partners for possible linkages and support;

ARTICLE 2
Bookkeeping and Reportorial Requirements

BOTH PARTIES shall keep a regular book of accounts and maintain separate and accurate records of their transactions in accordance with the bookkeeping laws, rules and regulations. BOTH PARTIES shall likewise report to each other from time to time about the latest development of the programs.

ARTICLE 3
Establishing a Board of Consulters

BOTH PARTIES hereto agree on the establishment of the Board of Consulters (BOC), which shall be composed of the 3 authorized representatives, 1 from the FIRST PARTY, 1 from the SECOND PARTY, and 1 duly nominated by BOTH PARTIES. The BOC shall monitor, coordinate and ensure the proper implementation and execution of this Agreement. The Board shall meet on a quarterly basis or as needed. Should there be a need for a major decision/s to be made outside the agreed MOA, a unanimous decision is required.


ARTICLE 4
