WHEREAS, Section 17 of the Local Government Code states that the construction of infrastructure facilities that are geared towards the delivery of basic services are part of the general powers and attributes of the Local Government Units;

WHEREAS, to provide for a conducive office and area for holding of activities and programs for the faculty, personnel and eventually for the pupils, a multi-purpose building is essential within the school grounds of the ever-growing community of San Francisco Elementary School;

WHEREAS, the current oldest building at San Francisco Elementary School has not been utilized by the school's administration because of its hazardous condition waiting to be declared as condemned;

WHEREAS, this Municipality is one with the Provincial Government in its thrust on giving utmost importance to Education as an integral part of its Mission and Vision for the Province of Rizal specifically by providing "access to education" and "dependable infrastructure achievable through effective and responsible governance...";

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the 11th Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in a session duly assembled, hereby RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS THE HONORABLE GOVERNOR REBECCA A. YNARES TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A 2-STOREY MULTI-PURPOSE BUILDING AT SAN FRANCISCO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, BARANGAY MUZON, TAYTAY RIZAL REPLACING THE DILAPIDATED OLD KITCHEN STRUCTURE WITHIN THE CAMPUS;
