



DRAFT ORDINANCE NO. **2209-017**

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING SUBSIDY TO FRESH GRADUATES FROM
TAYTAY PUBLIC SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL TAKING THE COMPETENCY
ASSESSMENT FOR NATIONAL CERTIFICATE, PROVIDING FUNDS
THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code mandates local government units to promote the general welfare of the people thru measures geared towards accelerating economic development and upgrading the quality of life for the people in the community; and shall "enhance economic prosperity..." and "promote full employment among their residents...";

WHEREAS, Senior High School graduates can strengthen their employment eligibility by obtaining a National Certificate that has been a criterion for many employers in hiring a fresh graduate, wherein the certification would imply that the aspiring workers have met defined competency standards needed in the company being applied at;

WHEREAS, a number of new graduates, year after year, do not have the means to pay for an assessment for them to be a National Certificate (NC) holder which is important in certifying the skills that Senior High School graduates possess thus providing them better opportunities to be gainfully employed;

WHEREAS, it is part of the thrust of the local government of Taytay to provide opportunities for reputable employment for its constituents geared towards the betterment of the community in general; thus there is a need to design a sustainable subsidy program for the aforementioned assessment;

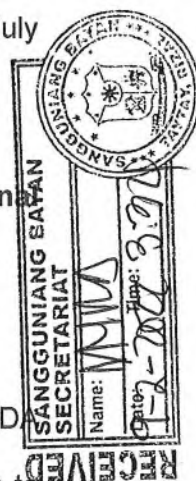
NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the 12th Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay in a session duly assembled that:

Section 1. Short Title

This Ordinance shall be known as the "**Free Competency Assessment for National Certification for Taytay Public Senior High School Fresh Graduates Ordinance**"

Section 2. Definition of Terms - as used in this Ordinance, the following shall mean:

- a) **NC** - National Certificate issued to passers of competency assessment which TESDA has a registry of certified workers
- b) **Strand** - degree-specific courses for the Academic track in senior high school aims to prepare students to more advanced university courses
- c) **Graduate** - a person who has received a diploma upon completing all the requirements of Senior High School of the current academic year
- d) **Assessment Fee** - total cost based on the course the graduate will be assessed
- e) **Senior High School** - this shall refer to the Public Senior High Schools under DepEd within the bounds of Taytay, Rizal
- f) **Subsidy** - the financial assistance that will be bestowed by the Municipal Government of Taytay to qualified Senior High School graduates as full payment for the competency assessment for National Certificate
- g) **Assessment** - the Competency Assessment for National Certificate done by TESDA accredited personnel
- h) **Applicant** - the Grade 12 Graduate/ Senior High School Completer from any Public Senior High School in Taytay applying for subsidy for assessment for a National Certification



64 **Section 3. Qualifications and Requirements**

66 a. The subsidy program on Competency Assessment for National Certificate shall be open
67 to deserving *bona fide* fresh graduates from any Public Senior High Schools operating in Taytay,
68 Rizal
69 b. The Applicant for the subsidy program shall be officially included in the list of
70 Graduates/Grade 12 completers of the Public Senior High School he/she is enrolled in.
71 c. The Applicant can only apply for the subsidy on the same academic year as his/her
72 graduation/completion of the K-12 program from any public senior school in Taytay
73 d. The Applicant can only avail of the subsidy once regardless of the result of the assessment
74 e. The Applicant must pass the Self-Assessment Guide (SAG) from TESDA before applying
75 for the subsidy
76 f. The Annual Net Family income should not exceed Php 65,000.00
77 g. The Applicant shall submit his/her application to the NC Subsidy Committee Secretariat

80 **Section 4. Funding Source**

81
82 For this purpose, the Municipal Government of Taytay shall appropriate the amount of
83 approximately Php 400,000.00 or higher annually from the General Fund.

85 The Municipality, upon the recommendation of the NC Subsidy Committee, may increase
86 the appropriated funds when deemed necessary.

89 **Section 5. The National Certificate Subsidy Committee**

91 The Local Chief Executive shall form an NC Subsidy Committee composed of the
92 following:

- 93 a. One representative designated by the Municipal Mayor
94 b. One representative from the Local School Board
95 c. One representative from Youth Affairs Office
96 d. One representative from each Public Senior High School operating in Taytay
97 e. One representative from the Taytay GPTA Federation – Senior High School level
98 f. Representative from the Public Employment Services Office
99

100 The committee shall be responsible for the screening of the applicants and shall recommend
101 to the Local Chief Executive the approval of the subsidy beneficiaries.
102

103 The Public Employment Services Office shall serve as the Secretariat of the NC Subsidy
104 Committee since it has a physical office within the Municipal Hall that will link the workforce to the
105 possible employers

108 **Section 6. Implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR)**

110 The IRR shall be prepared by the NC Subsidy Committee and shall be submitted to the
111 Municipal Mayor for his approval prior to its implementation.

114 **Section 7. Repealing Clause**

116 All Ordinances contrary to this Ordinance are hereby repealed accordingly

118 **Section 8. Effectivity Clause**

120 This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
