ORDINANCE NO. 47 series of 2020

AN ORDINANCE UPDATING THE PRESCRIBED GUIDELINES AND REGULATING MOBILITY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, PROVINCE OF RIZAL DECLARED AS ONE OF THE AREAS UNDER GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE

WHEREAS, Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) on the management of emerging infectious disease had issued Resolution No. 64 series of 2020, on August 17, 2020 approving the placing of the National Capital Region, and the provinces of Bulacan, Cavite, Laguna, and Rizal under General Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, to ensure continuity of the national agencies effort and measures to cascade down to the local community for implementation in battling the effect of COVID-19 Pandemic, an updated local legislation of guidelines for this purpose is needed;

WHEREAS, the 11th Sangguniang Bayan finds the need to update the existing Ordinances prescribing guidelines and regulating mobility in the Municipality of Taytay, Province of Rizal declared as one of the areas under General Community Quarantine to best serve the purpose;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the 11th Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in session duly assembled, that:

Section 1. Curfew Hours – From 8:00 PM to 5:00 AM

Exempted from the curfew hours are Authorized Person Outside of Residence (APOR) going to and from work.

Section 2. Elderly and Youth – Any person below twenty-one (21) years old, those who are sixty (60) years old and above, those with immunodeficiency, comorbidities, or health risk, and pregnant women, including any person who resides with the aforementioned, shall be required to remain in their residence at all times, except when indispensable under the circumstances for obtaining essential goods and services or for work in permitted industries and offices.

Section 3. Home Quarantine Pass / COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass – Approved Person Outside of Residence (APOR) shall be allowed to go out of their homes without Home Quarantine Pass / COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass but shall not be allowed to purchase any goods without presenting their Quarantine Pass / Household Pass. As per recommendation of the PNP Taytay, the COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass will still be issued by the PNP Taytay together with Purok / Sitio Chairman in the five Barangays, One Pass per Household, free of charge and shall not be sold. Violators will be dealt with accordingly.

Local Government Employees' ID and Health Workers ID can be used as Home Quarantine Pass for purchase of essential goods.

The new Quarantine Pass will be distributed and shall be called COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass.


Old Barangay issued Quarantine Passes shall be honored by establishments until such time that the new Zoning and Household Passes have been fully distributed by the PNP Taytay.

Section 4. Travel Authority – The Travel Authority is issued by the Taytay Philippine National Police for Locally Stranded Individuals (LSI) and Repatriated Overseas Filipino Worker (ROF). The following Requirement shall be submitted to the Office Operation Section of Taytay Municipal Police Station (Kadalagahan St., Brgy. Dolores, Taytay, Rizal Contact Nos. 0936-9507608 / 8 685 7267). Strictly Incomplete Requirements, No Travel Authority

1. Barangay Clearance
2. Medical Health Certificate stating that the LSI/ROFs is neither a contact suspect of probable or confirmed COVID Cases.
3. Letter Request from Applicant/Requesting Party indicating the following:
 - a. Names with Contact Number
 - b. Point of Origin and Destination
 - c. Travel Date
 - d. Purpose
 - e. Details of vehicle with Plate Number (OR/CR) and Photocopy of Driver's License of the driver.

Issuance of Travel Authority is subject to the Guidelines issued by the National Agencies concerned.

Section 5. Government Offices – Work in Government Offices may be at full capacity, or under such alternative work arrangements as agencies may deem proper in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations issued by the Civil Service Commission (CSC).



Section 6. Transportation – All Public and Private Transportation are allowed to operate in reduced capacity.

A. Tricycle

On August 4, 2020, the Taytay Municipal Tricycle Franchising and Regulatory Office (TMTFRO) issued the necessary guidelines in particular for implementation under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine. The same guidelines shall still be followed for implementation under General Community Quarantine

B. Motorcycle

As stated by the National Task Force Against COVID-19 on August 18, 2020, the approved Transition Protocol on Motorcycle Back Riding under General Community Quarantine are as follows:

- For Riders living in the same house, no need for motorcycle barrier.
- For Riders not living in the same house, must have Angkas designed barrier.
- The Back Rider must be an APOR.
- The Driver may or may not be an APOR.
- Motorcycle must be privately owned and not for hire.
- Both Riders should have Face Masks and full-face helmets that must be worn all the time while back riding.



C. Shuttle Service


The Local Government Unit of Taytay shall provide free shuttle services within the bounds of Taytay for MEDICAL HEALTH WORKERS ONLY who will be reporting for work and going home. The official company ID of the MEDICAL HEALTH WORKERS shall be presented to the shuttle service provider to be allowed access to the service.

Section 7. Establishments Allowed to Operate – establishments listed below shall be allowed to operate form 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM only. No person shall be allowed entry to any establishments within the Municipality without facemasks and face shields / safety eye shields / safety protective goggles. (Eyeglasses and sunglasses are not considered as safety protective equipment) No Quarantine Pass / Household Pass, No Buy Policy shall be required. Except for Health Workers and Government Employees.

Category I Industries - Power, energy, water, and other utilities, agriculture, fishery, and forestry industries, food manufacturing and food supply chain businesses, including food retail establishments such as supermarkets, grocery stores, and food preparation establishments insofar as take-out and delivery services, food delivery services, health-related establishments, the logistics sector, information technology and telecommunication companies, the media, at full operational capacity;

Category II Industries – Mining and other manufacturing, and electronic commerce companies, as well as other delivery, repair and maintenance, and housing and office services, at anywhere between fifty percent (50%) up to full operational capacity, and without prejudice to work-from-home and other alternative work arrangements; and

Category III Industries – Financial services, legal and accounting, and auditing services, professional, scientific, technical, and other non-leisure services, barbershops and salons and other non-leisure wholesale and retail establishments, from skeleton workforce to fifty percent (50%) operational



capacity, and without prejudice to work-from-home and other alternative work arrangements.

The foregoing lists of sectors and industries per category are illustrative. Specific industries under each category are reflected in a separate document issued by the DTI which shall contain the updated guidelines to implement gradual increase of operational and venue capacity including operating hours, without diminution of the current capacities and hours previously allowed. This is without prejudice to the authority of the DTI to recategorize Category IV industries as may be found in Paragraph (9) of the IATF Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines with Amendments as of July 16, 2020.




- A. **Food Establishments** – shall be allowed to operate from 5:00 AM to 7:00 PM. Food handlers shall be required to wear protective/transport masks, gloves and hairnet at all times. All customers are highly encouraged to bring their own containers and bags for the said purpose. All establishments shall provide queues/lines that practice strict social distancing from the entrance up to the payment area.
- B. **Supermarkets/Groceries/Convenience Stores/Drug Store/Pharmacy/Sari-Sari Store** - shall be allowed to operate for twelve (12) hours but not exceeding curfew hours, the sari-sari store shall be allowed to operate only for essential products from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM, provided that social Distancing is observed at all times especially when queuing for payment. Senior Citizens/PWD's/and priority lanes shall be present in all stores following the provisions of existing laws. All establishments shall provide queues/lines that practice strict social distancing from the entrance up to the payment area.
- C. **Mall Hours** – Operation Time of allowed establishments / Tenants shall be from 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM, except supermarket and pharmacy that shall follow Section 7.b of this Ordinance. No face mask and face shields / safety eye shields / safety protective goggles (Eyeglasses and sunglasses are not considered as safety protective equipment), No entry and Restricted Persons (as stated in Section 4.7 of the IATF Omnibus guidelines on implementation of Community Quarantine) shall not be allowed entry.

Section 8. Establishments NOT Allowed to Operate - Amusement, gaming, and fitness establishment, as well as those in the kids and the tourism industries, and all **Category IV** industries may not operate. Industries in Category IV are reflected in the DTI issuance as mentioned in section 7 of this ordinance.

Section 9. Market Place – this pertains TO all public and private market, recognized talipapas and ambulant vendors / sidewalk vendors in the municipality. It is mandatory to wear Facemask and Face Shield / Safety Eye Shield / Safety Protective Goggles (eyeglasses and sunglasses are not considered as safety protective equipment) for all stall holders / staff / personnel / vendors, buyers / market goers, market suppliers / delivery personnel and Market Personnel.

- A. **New Taytay Public Market/Old Market** – shall be in operation from 5:00 AM to 12:00 NN and 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM. All personnel assigned to the NTPM/EEDM shall regularly monitor that social distancing is being strictly observed by all market goers and vendors at all times. Color coding for market goers will be implemented wherein those with BLUE stickers provided by the EEDM shall be allowed entry to public markets on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and those with BLACK stickers on Tuesdays, Thursday and Saturdays. No color coding is in place during Sundays. RED stickers shall be provided to Dealers, Sellers, Suppliers and Hauling Personnel. No COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass, No Buy policy shall be observed by the sellers. All establishments shall provide queues/lines that practice strict social distancing from the entrance up to the payment area.



B. **All Recognized Talipapas** shall operate from 5:00 AM to 12:00 NN and 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM only.

C. **Ambulant Vendors/Sidewalk Vendors** shall be prohibited across the municipality at all times

Section 10. Tiangge – Those operators and vendors who already applied for the re-opening of their Tiangge and has been given permit to operate prior to this Ordinance shall be allowed with 50% capacity operation subject to minimum public health protocols. Those who have a pending application shall be subject for approval by the Office of the Mayor.

Section 11. Liquor Ban – The sale of all types of alcoholic drinks shall be allowed from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM only. Selling of any types of Liquor outside the allowed time shall be subject to penalties stipulated under this Ordinance. Consuming of any Alcoholic drinks in public places is hereby prohibited. No Quarantine Pass / Household Pass, No Buy Policy shall be required.

Section 12. Videoke Rental – The rent/lease of Videoke machines shall be prohibited to avoid the spreading of disease/virus thru the use of communal microphones.

Section 13. Gatherings – All forms of gambling shall be prohibited specially in wakes. Visiting wakes shall be encouraged to be until 7:00 PM only. All sports activities and leagues shall be suspended. All multi-purpose gyms and courts shall be closed for public gatherings and any sports activities. All common religious congregations shall be discouraged to avoid the spread of the virus. All festivities and traditional acts such as Senakulo, Penitensya and the likes are likewise prohibited. Only a maximum of ten (10) persons is allowed to be physically present for religious gathering.

Section 14. Waste Segregation. – All households are mandated to observe proper waste segregation and waste disposal as the hauling and collection of garbage is currently hampered by the current community quarantine from adjacent areas.

Section 15. Closure of Roads – The Municipal Mayor is authorized to issue closure of roads, if necessary, as a preventive measure for the spread of the COVID-19 virus.


Section 16. Schools – Physical classes shall be suspended for the duration of the GCQ.

This notwithstanding, Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) may hold classes through flexible learning arrangements to finish the Academic Year 2019-2020, and may operate at a limited capacity to receive students' requirements and prepare and issue credentials to students subject to the guidelines as may be issued by the Commission on Higher Education.

Section 17. Constructions – As per Department Order No. 39 series of 2020 from the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), All public and private construction projects shall be allowed, but with strict compliance to the construction safety guidelines issued by the DPWH for the implementation of infrastructure projects during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Section 18. Monitoring and Implementation. – Philippines National Police (PNP-Taytay), The Local Government Unit of Taytay and all Barangay Local Government Units shall monitor and implement the provisions of this ordinance. They shall strictly monitor that all establishments are providing queues/lines that practice strict social distancing from the entrance up to the payment area.

Section 19. Penalty Clause – A Fine ranging from P 1,000 to P 2,500 and/or imprisonment for 10 to 30 days at the discretion of the proper court shall be imposed for individual for every violation of the provisions of this ordinance. Subsequent / Habitual Violations for business establishments may lead to Closure of establishments concerned to a maximum of three (3) days and revocation of Business Permit, likewise, failure to comply with the "No Home Quarantine Pass / COVID-19 Zoning and Household Pass, No selling" shall result in the same.



Section 20. Information Dissemination – The Public Information Office of this Municipality and the Barangay shall spearhead the information dissemination of this ordinance. Official details regarding COVID-19 updates from the municipality shall come from official memorandum issued by Municipal Health Office and posted at the official page of the Taytay Public Information Office.

Section 21. Separability Clause - If any provision of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other provisions hereof.

Section 22. Effectivity Clause - This ordinance shall take effect immediately and upon approval. This ordinance shall likewise be in effect every time that the municipality is placed under General Community Quarantine (GCQ) by the National Government.

Section 23. Colatilla – Policies shall be stricter from time to time as the need arises. All statutes and policies by the Local Government Unit of Taytay shall be on a day to day basis based on the pronouncements of National Government Agencies or higher offices
