ORDINANCE NO. 734 series of 2022

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING FABRIC OR TEXTILE CONES AND THE LIKES

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that: "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.";



WHEREAS, the garments industry is the primary industry in our municipality, and fabric or textiles are the most common commodity of use in our production of clothes or Ready to Wear (RTW) clothes;

WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the sale of textiles with cone as holder or hardener or tightener at the center of textiles or fabrics;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Definition of Terms:

- 1. Fabrics or Textiles materials use for the production of clothes
- 2. Cones or the Likes a solid or hollow object that tapers from a circular or roughly circular base use as holder or hardener or tightener at the center of textiles or fabrics
- 3. Fabrics or Textiles Seller all types of sellers, whether whole sales or retailers, who are selling all types or kinds of fabrics or textiles within the Municipality of Taytay, whether local or imported textiles
- 4. Taytay Garments Council created under Municipal Ordinance No. 712 series of 2021

SECTION 2. Prohibited Acts

- 1. It is strictly prohibited to sell textiles or fabrics with cones weighing more than 1 kilo.
- 2. It is strictly prohibited to use other kinds of materials which serves as hardener or holder or tightener at the center of the textiles or fabrics weighing more than 1 kilo.
- **SECTION 3. Temporary Stipulation** Those sellers of textiles and fabrics that will be caught selling goods with hardener / tightener / holder at the center exceeding 1 kilo shall be compelled to deduct from the total amount due the excess weight based on the actual selling price. This stipulation shall take effect from March 2022 until August 31, 2022 only, after which no more cones weighing more than 1 kilo shall be allowed.
- **SECTION 4. Penalty** Violators shall be meted a fine not exceeding Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 2,500.00) or an imprisonment for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or both in the discretion of the court and revocation of business permits.
- **SECTION 5. Implementing Rules and Regulations** Upon consultation with the stakeholders, the Local Chief Executive, may, if necessary, formulate the applicable implementing rules and regulations of this Ordinance.
- **SECTION 6.** Separability Clause If for any reason, a part of this Ordinance is declared illegal or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall remain valid and in full force and effect.
- **SECTION 7. Repealing Clause** Insofar as inconsistent herewith and all existing ordinances, executive ordinances, executive orders and administrative regulations or part of parts thereof which are inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


