RESOLUTION NO. 76

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING TO THE NATIONAL HISTORICAL
INSTITUTE THRU THE BUREAU OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT
SUPERVISION THE PROPOSED CORPORATE SEAL OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, RIZAL.

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Local Government Supervision is mandated to review the proposed corporate deals of Local Government Units and register the same, after the approval of the National Historical Institute, pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 22 (b) of R.A. 7160, as implemented by DILG Memorandum Circular No. 92-30 dated June 18, 1992;

WHEREAS, there is a need for every Local Government Unit to have a corporate seal that will signify its singular identity;

WHEREAS, hereunder are the narrative description or symbolism of objects in corporated therein for proper visual representation of the proposed corporate seal:

1. The entire seal is circular in shape where the identity of our Municipality and Province is identified in its colored yellow background.
2. The inside portion is an emblem with a shape of a badge.
 - a. The white background super imposed three stars colored yellow, represent our service to GOD, COUNTRY and PEOPLE.
 - b. At the center is the sun colored yellow gold, which represent our province and the fourteen rays represent the fourteen towns of Rizal.

- c. The left portion of the emblem colored blue, with the background of ethnic hand saw, hammer and chisel, represent the woodwork industry of our municipality which we have been known for sometimes.
- d. On the right portion of the emblem colored red, has the background of a hand operated sewing machine and a scissor which represent another industry, which our municipality is known for and that is "DRESS MAKING INDUSTRY (R.T.W.).
- e. The upper portion of the emblem bear five (5) stars colored yellow gold, which represent our five (5) Barangays.
- f. On the lower portion of the emblem is a ribbon shape colored yellow, represent our National identity.
- g. The color of the background is gray to neutralized all the colores.

NOW THEREFORE, after due deliberation and exchange of ideas, on motion of Coun. Carlos V. Borja and unanimously seconded, it was,

RESOLVED, as it is hereby being resolved to endorse as it is hereby endorsed the proposed corporate seal of the municipality of Taytay, Rizal, to the National Historical Institute thru the Bureau of Local Government Supervision of D.I.L.G.;
