RESOLUTION NO. 85

A RESOLUTION URGING THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF TAYTAY (BUSINESS & LICENSE PERMIT OFFICE) THE STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF SOCIAL SECURITY ACT OF 1997 (REPUBLIC ACT 8282)

WHEREAS, Republic Act 8282 under Section 24. **Employment Records and Reports** states that: " Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, local government units shall, prior to issuing any annual business license or permit require submission of certificate of SSS coverage and compliance with provision of this Act: Provided: That the certification or clearance shall be issued by the SSS within five (5) working days from the receipt of the request."

WHEREAS, Section 28. **Penal Clause** states that: " Whoever fails or refuse to comply with the provision of this Act or with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Commission, shall be punished by a fine of not less that Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) nor more than Twenty Thousand Pesos (P20,000.00), or imprisonment for not less than six (6) years and one (1) day nor more than twelve (12) years or both, at the


discretion of the court: Provided, that where the violation consists in failure or refusal to register employees or himself, in case of the covered self-employed, or to deduct contribution from the employee's compensation and remit the same to the same to the SSS, the penalty shall be a fine of not less than Five thousand pesos (P5,000.00) nor more that Twenty thousand pesos (P20,000.00) and imprisonment for not less than six (6) years and one (1) day no more than twelve (12) years. If the act or omission or penalized by this Act committed by an association, partnership, corporation or any other institution, its managing head, directors or partners shall be liable to the penalties provided in this Act for the offense.

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Sangguniang Bayan, in a session duly assembled hereby URGING THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF TAYTAY(BUSINESS & LICENSE PERMIT OFFICE) FOR THE STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF SOCIAL SECURITY ACT OF 1997 (REPUBLIC ACT 8282).


RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished all concerned for their information and appropriate action.
