RESOLUTION NO. 137

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO
DENGUE HEMORRHAGIC FEVER IN MUNICIPALITY OF
TAYTAY, PROVINCE OF RIZAL AND CHARGING FROM
CALAMITY FUND THE AMOUNT OF PHP. 292,945.00 FOR THE
PURPOSE.**

WHEREAS, with the advent of the rainy season, the environment is again exposed to some of the commonly known illnesses or life threatening diseases or viruses that are either airborne, communicable, medically infused or inflicted by harmful parasites or insects;

WHEREAS, it is medically recognized fact, that Dengue Hemorrhagic Fever is a life threatening disease and has claimed lives of those who have been bitten its carrier if not attended to properly and at the soonest possible time of detention;

WHEREAS, reports have already reached the Municipal Health Office, as per Local Health Board Resolution No 005-01 a possible spread

of the Dengue fever among people is imminent and had reach an alarming rate, considering that there are thirteen (13) cases that have been found positive as of August 2005 and as per the computation of Outbreak 11 cases can be considered as a calamity;

WHEREAS, in order to promote the general welfare, specially on health and safety of the people, it becomes imperative that a declaration of state of calamity be affirmed.


WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan deems it necessary to set aside the amount of Php. 292,945.00 from the Calamity Fund;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, the Sangguniang Bayan hereby Declares a State of Calamity due to Dengue Hemorrhagic Fever Outbreak in Municipality of Taytay, Province of Rizal and charging from the Calamity Fund the amount of P. 292,945.00 for the purpose;


RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to all concerned for their information and appropriate action;

ADOPTED, this 19th day of September 2005 at the Sangguniang Session Hall of the Municipal Building, Taytay, Rizal


