**RE-AFFIRMING AND HIGHLY RECOMMENDING TO THE LOCAL
CHIEF EXECUTIVE HON. GEORGE RICARDO R. GACULA II TO
EXECUTE AND CARRY OUT SANGGUNIANG BAYAN RESOLUTION
NO. 15 SERIES OF 2009 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISION OF
R.A. 7718 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, The 7th Sangguniang Bayan had passed a Resolution No. 15 series of 2009 amending Resolution No. 186. A Resolution authorizing the Municipal Mayor, Hon. George Ricardo R. Gacula II, to negotiate and enter into Memorandum of Agreement with any private entity that can give adequate and just package program for the proposed built-operate-transfer scheme for the new Taytay Public Market Building C and the Development of Multi-level parking;

WHEREAS, the implementation of the project was effectively concurred by the Provincial Government of Rizal through its Provincial Development Council Resolution No. 2009-11;

WHEREAS, in line with the National Government direction of encouraging more Public Private Partnership (PPP) in the pursuit of the country's development programs and projects, the Municipal Government aims to tap the vast resources, technical capabilities and experience of the private sector in implementing the aforesaid project;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government deems its best that the private sector be invited to give their proposals to design, build, transfer and operate the said multi-level parking under a competitive bidding process and in accordance with the provision of the BOT Law, in order to seek the best and most advantageous agreement for the Local Government and in doing so avail of the needed expertise for the activity while at the same time attaining savings on operational and maintenance costs of said multi-level parking;

WHEREAS, in order to maximize the potential of the subject lot, a Municipal Government-owned prime landholding, and for the Local Government to make greater beneficial use of said valuable asset;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government has already developed adequate and just package program for the proposed built-operate-transfer scheme for the development of multi-level parking;


WHEREAS, the aforementioned costs savings that the Municipal Government may realize, may thus be re-allocated for other priority projects and programs for the people of Taytay;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved the Sangguniang Bayan duly assembled in session re-affirming and highly recommend to the Local Chief Executive, Hon. George Ricardo R. Gacula II, to execute and carry out Sangguniang Bayan Resolution No. 15 series of 2009 in accordance with the provision of Republic 7718 and for other purposes;


RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to all concerned for their information and appropriate action.
