RESOLUTION NO. 300 series of 2018

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE
HON. GEORGE RICARDO R. GACULA II TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT
ORDINANCE NO. 21 SERIES OF 2002 ENTITLED:
"THE MARKET CODE OF TAYTAY, RIZAL"**

WHEREAS, Section 16 – General Welfare of the Republic Act 7160 also known as the Local Government Code of 1991 states that:

"Every Local Government Unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of general welfare..."

WHEREAS, a fire incident occurred last May 19, 2018 which affected the stakeholders and/or vendors of New Taytay Public Market Building (B);

WHEREAS, Section 4A.01-11 - Unlawful Acts under The Market Code of Taytay 2002 states that:

“It is declared unlawful for any person to store, sell and/or possess inflammable materials like gasoline, thinner and all such other materials, power or liquid, classified by the National Fire Department Code as inflammable items shall be prohibited. Store outside market premises shall also be prohibited from storing said materials within a 50 meters radius.

WHEREAS, Section 6C.02 - Use of Alleys and Passageways under The Market Code of Taytay 2002 states that;

“Alleys and Passageways at all times must be free from any obstruction and other personal belongings by person and or any ambulant vendor’s should strictly prohibited. Any person found vending or offering any goods or items for sale at the passageways shall be taken into custody by the Market Master or his duly authorized representative. Said goods or items will serve as evidence against the ambulant vendors or person/s thereby giving the market authorities the right to charge applicable violation provided for in this code.”

WHEREAS, Section 6C.03 - Stall Holders and/or Vendor’s Welfare under The Market Code of Taytay 2002 states that;


“In accordance with the policy of extending assistance and support to legitimate stallholders and/or vendors, all areas including streets, sidewalks, vacant lots whether private or public, situated within 50 meters from the perimeter of the Public Market, is hereby declared as “prohibited” vending zones. No make shift stalls, pushcarts, ambulant vendors and the like shall be allowed within the prohibited zones.”

WHEREAS, there is a need for strict implementation of the Market Code of Taytay 2002, to avoid the same incident in the future;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the 10th Sangguniang Bayan duly assembled in session, hereby requests the Local Chief Executive Hon. George Ricardo R. Gacula II to strictly implement the Ordinance No. 21 series of 2002 entitled: “The Market Code of Taytay, Rizal.”

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of the resolution be furnished to all concerned so that the prompt action of the 10th Sangguniang Bayan on the needed legislative measures can be facilitated and undertaken accordingly;
