**A RESOLUTION INITIATING A FOLLOW-UP FOR APPROPRIATE ACTION TO
BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE MANILA ELECTRIC RAILROAD AND LIGHT
COMPANY (MERALCO) ON THE REQUEST STATED IN SANGGUNIANG
BAYAN RESOLUTION NO. 226, SERIES OF 2017 ENTITLED: A RESOLUTION
REQUESTING THE MERALCO INCORPORATED TO IMMEDIATELY
RELOCATE THEIR ELECTRIC POST THAT OBSTRUCT THE FLOW OF
TRAFFIC IN MAJOR THOROUGHFARES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY**

WHEREAS, the traffic congestion had been a noted factor in the hindrance of achieving full economic growth and development of our nation, particularly in the busy fast growing metropolis, adjacent towns like the Municipality of Taytay and other nearby localities;

WHEREAS, the National, Provincial and Local Government had been responsive in addressing the needs through the provision of additional roads, bridges, pedestrian overpasses drainages and widening of already existing roads to fully address the concern, if not completely but at least lighten the worsening situation of traffic;

WHEREAS, based on the observation and comments made by the residents and constituents from all walks of life passing the area of Ortigas Avenue Extension particularly from Tropical Supermarket to Valleygolf and all the other areas within Rizal Avenue of the town proper of the Municipality of Taytay, the supposed to be smooth flowing of traffic brought by road widening were hampered by the Old Electric Post which up to this time have not yet been relocated;


WHEREAS, the 10th Sangguniang Bayan had adopted Resolution 226 (herein attached) during the 54th Regular Session dated September 7, 2017 and eventually furnished copies to Manila Electric Railroad and Light Company (MERALCO) Incorporation both in the Main Office located in Ortigas, Pasig City and District Field Office located in Cainta, Rizal for their proper action and consideration;
