RESOLUTION NO. 88 series of 2019

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10410 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS
EARLY YEARS ACT OF 2013 FOR THE BENEFIT OF YOUNG CHILDREN WITH
THE AGE OF ZERO TO EIGHT YEARS OLD WHO RESIDES IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, PROVINCE OF RIZAL**

WHEREAS, under this law it was declared the policy of the State to promote the rights of children to survival, development and special protection with full recognition of the nature of childhood and as well as the need to provide developmentally appropriate experiences to address their needs;

WHEREAS, under this Act there are certain objectives that needs to be implemented and emphasize for the benefit of young children and their parents, as well as, children with special needs particular to their health and nutrition, their physical motor, socio-emotional, language, psychological and spiritual development;

WHEREAS, one of the objectives in the said Act is to enhance and sustain the efforts of communities to promote the Early Childhood Care and Development programs and ensure that special support is provided for poor, disadvantaged and linguistic minority community;

WHEREAS, in this Act it also ensures the education of persons, and in particular children, who are blind, deaf, or deafblind and other disabilities, are conducted in the most appropriate languages, modes and means of communication for the individual and in environments which maximizes academic and social development;


WHEREAS, this Act will give more benefits to our young children with the age of zero to eight years old, especially children with special needs, to protect their rights to learn, to live and to have an equal social development;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the 11th Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, in session duly assembled, hereby ADOPTS REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10410 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS EARLY YEARS ACT OF 2013 FOR THE BENEFIT OF YOUNG CHILDREN WITH THE AGE OF ZERO TO EIGHT YEARS OLD WHO RESIDES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY, PROVINCE OF RIZAL.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to all concerned for their information and appropriate action.
