RESOLUTION NO. 386 series of 2019

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE
HON. GEORGE RICARDO R. GACULA II TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT ALL
LAWS CONCERNING JUNKSHOP ESTABLISHMENT AND THE REVIEW OF
ALL BUSINESS PERMITS OF EXISTING JUNKSHOPS IN THE MUNICIPALITY**

WHEREAS, there were a lot of complaints received due to proliferation of junkshops all over our municipality;

WHEREAS, it was found out that many of them were in the residential areas and could cause health and environment hazard;

WHEREAS, most of them do not have sufficient facilities to operate a junkshop and they occupies the pavements and road, that causes traffic congestions in the area;

WHEREAS, most of them violates sanitation and environmental laws;

WHEREAS, some of them cover themselves to be operating on a trading business, but ends up to be another junkshop just like the others;

WHEREAS, some of them were catering or buying stolen items from thieves and youths that were hook into illegal drugs and/or other illegal substances;

WHEREAS, RA. 7160, the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the Sangguniang Bayan the following;

SECTION. 447.- Powers, Duties, Functions xxxxxx ...

Subsection 2 (vi) Prescribe reasonable limits and restraints on the use of property within the jurisdiction of the municipality;

(viii) Reclassify land within the jurisdiction of the municipality, subject to the pertinent provisions of this Code;

(ix) Enact integrated zoning ordinances in consonance with the approved comprehensive land use plan, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations; establish fire limits or zones, particularly in populous centers; and regulate the construction, repair or modification of buildings within said fire limits or zones in accordance with the provisions of the Fire Code;

Subsection 3 (ii) Regulate any business, occupation, or practice of profession or calling which does not require government examination within the municipality and the conditions under which the license for said business or practice of profession may be issued or revoked...

Subsection 4 (ii) Require that buildings and the premises thereof and any land within the municipality be kept and maintained in a sanitary condition; impose penalties for any violation thereof, or upon failure to comply with said requirement, have the work done and require the owner, administrator or tenant concerned to pay the expenses of the same; or require the filling up of any land or premises to a grade necessary for proper sanitation;

Subsection 5 (vi) Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges, prohibit the putting up of encroachments or obstacles thereon, and, when necessary in the interest of public welfare, authorize the removal of encroachments and illegal constructions in public places;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, As It Is Hereby Resolved, by the 10th Sangguniang Bayan of Taytay, Rizal, In Session Duly Assembled, hereby, **REQUESTS THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE HON. GEORGE RICARDO R. GACULA II TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT ALL LAWS CONCERNING JUNKSHOP ESTABLISHMENT AND THE REVIEW OF ALL BUSINESS PERMITS OF EXISTING JUNKSHOPS IN THE MUNICIPALITY**

RESOLVED FURTHER, that, there will be no new applications for junkshop or the likes, to be allowed anywhere in our municipality, until the enactment of an ordinance regulating the establishment and operations of junkshops and the likes in our municipality;

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that, those who were given renewal of permits for their junkshop businesses shall be covered by the new ordinance to be enacted for that purpose, and if they are found to be in violation thereof, shall be penalized accordingly;


RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that, the Sangguniang Bayan Resolution No. 374^{Dist} shall be extended, for junkshops and/or the likes, until the enactment of the ordinance for the purpose;

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that the Business Permit and Licensing Office and Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office shall furnished the Sangguniang Bayan with all available data of junkshop business in the municipality for purposes of legislation;


RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, to send copies of adopted Resolution to all concerned offices and agencies for their appropriate action;
